SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

There are a number of scholarships available from Masonic groups. Our program is exclusive to high school seniors graduating from Ballard, Ingraham, Nathan Hale and Roosevelt High Schools.

We will be awarding four scholarships this year. The scholarships will be for \$1,000.00. One of the four scholarships, to be selected by a lottery type drawing, will be for \$1,000.00 for each of the student's four years of undergraduate work provided that the student remains enrolled in an accredited, public post-secondary school. Payment will be made to the **public** school of the student's choice and not to the individual student. The funds may be used for direct institutional costs such as tuition, fees or books and not for living expenses.

You are eligible to apply if you meet the following conditions:

- A. Must be a graduating senior from one of the high schools listed above
- B. Must be a citizen of the United States or have a permanent visa
- C. Must attend an accredited **public**, post-secondary school
- D. Must need financial assistance to attend school
- E. Must be willing to submit to a personal interview

(Masonic family affiliation is not required, but is of interest to the committee.)

REQUIREMENTS – READ CAREFULLY

1. Fully complete the two forms (*Application and Financial Need Information*) and write your statement. You may attach extra pages if you wish to submit additional information. We must have a copy of your official high school grade transcript.
2. Your completed packet must be postmarked or hand delivered by midnight, Friday, April 2, 2010. Send to Ian Hyde, 225 North 70th Street, Seattle, WA 98103, phone (206) 356-5420.
3. In the event that you become a finalist, you should hold the evening of Thursday, April 29, 2010 open. This is the night scheduled for a personal interview by the committee with each of the finalists. Both those who are selected and those who are not selected as finalists will be notified by mail.
4. The award winners will receive a certificate at the Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, May 12, 2010 at the Greenwood Masonic Center, 7910 Greenwood Ave. N., Seattle, Washington. You must be in attendance to be eligible for the lottery drawing. We will have a buffet dinner beginning at 6:00 pm followed by the award ceremony at 7:00 pm.
5. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipients to keep the committee informed of his or her intent to register and where, prior to enrollment.
